

## **HAYWARD SATURDAY LEAGUE ROUND UP - SATURDAY 19<sup>th</sup> MARCH 2016**

Allendale Reserves are in a good run of form going into Thursday night's M. A. Hart Page Croft Cup Final at Hurn Bridge (7:30 pm) against **HAYWARD SATURDAY DIVISION TWO** rivals Bournemouth Electric Reserves. Leading marksman Henry Biglowe bagged a hat-trick for the second week running when Allendale thrashed Westover Bournemouth Reserves 8-0. Ricky Mee and Ricky Hearn added two each with Alex Forward also on target as 'Dale chalked up their fourth successive victory.

In contrast, Electric Reserves' title hopes were dented by a second successive defeat, this time at the hands of league leaders Queens Park Athletic who were 2-0 winners thanks to Luke Hughes and Stuart Senior in their final game of the season.

Portcastrian are ten points adrift of the leaders with six games in hand after their 9-1 hammering of Talbot Rise courtesy of River Smith's hat-trick and further goals from Alex Mackenzie (2), Ben Virabi (2), Stevie Rattue, and Seb Ridout.

In the other Division Two game, Jamie Tuvey netted for West Howe but they remain in the drop zone after Mudeford Mens Club just got the better of them 2-1 with goals from Alex Spencer and Josh Thayne.

Tom Bircham struck for tailenders Gotham in the **HAYWARD SATURDAY PREMIER DIVISION** but Bournemouth Sports swept them aside 3-1 thanks to Dan Manuel and a couple of goals from Nathan Edwards to go top of the table.

Unbeaten reigning champions Bournemouth Electric were 3-1 winners against Westover Bournemouth with goals from Lucas Gelsleichter, Dan Taylor, and Steve Flynn while Allendale maintained their excellent run since the turn of the year when they subdued Ferndown Sports 4-0 through Chris Danvers, Lorne Cooper-Blaney, George Knijff, and Matt Riggs.

Mark Wheeler and Luke Goddard netted for Hamworthy Recreation but Parley Sports had the upper hand 5-2 thanks to Ben Mowlam and Gareth Barnes' four goal blast.

Harry Rogers and Dan Hayward netted for third placed Redlynch & Woodfalls United in **DIVISION ONE** but Bisterne United surprised them 3-2 thanks to Andrew Hurl and a couple of goals from George Darnley. Bisterne now have a five point lead over bottom placed Ferndown Sports Reserves who crashed to a 6-0 defeat against Bournemouth Poppies, the goals coming via Stepan Neronski (2), Djamel Meddah (2), Oliver Waterhouse, and Sami Makhloufi.

**DIVISION THREE** pacesetters Boldre Rangers returned to winning ways when they gave Bisterne United Reserves a 5-0 drubbing through Alex Hilliard (2), Rob Crouch (2), and Brandon Page.

Throop United remain two points behind with three games in hand after their 8-1 triumph over Bournemouth Electric A with goals from Lascelles Richardson (2), John Bailey (2), Adam Parsons, Francesc Bosch Mira, Alex Hawey, and Carl Charman.

Fordingbridge Turks move up to third place with a 5-0 victory over New Milton Eagles thanks to Harry Stokes (2), Cal Fraser, Ali Brown, and Matt Jeneson and Bournemouth Manor A were also 5-0 winners when John Bastable (2), Ryan Davies, Kyle John-Clement, and Steve Clarke put paid to Milford.

In the only one of the five scheduled games to actually take place in **DIVISION FOUR**, tailenders Parkstone Athletic were on the receiving end again when AFC Bransgore ran out 6-0 winners with goals from Dom Taylor (2), Luke Bassil, Liam Roberts, Rhys Jessop, and Harry Boyt.

Cranborne, Burley, and Milford Club AFC were all unable to fulfil their fixtures while the pitch for the Alderholt A v Bransgore United game was declared unfit for play.
