Bournemouth Electric Reserves strengthened their grip on second place when Dean Seal scored the vital goal in their 1-0 success against Bisterne United while Bournemouth Manor Reserves and Queens Park Athletic cancelled each other out in a 0-0 draw.

Tailenders Alderholt Reserves netted through TK Mills, Daryll Mills, and Dan Elphick but that elusive first point of the season evaded them again when Portcastrian shaded it 4-3 with goals from Jamie Virabi (2), Tim Constable, and Ryan Irvin to move up to fourth place in the table.
