The Hammers deservedly led with a first half strike from Lascelles Richardson but Sam Purdy put Manor on terms immediately after the restart and they then took the lead through Ed Ewens. Lewis Cannings produced a moment of brilliance to equalise for the Hammers but Ewens struck again with another superb effort to give Manor the verdict 3-2.

Leaders Bournemouth Electric netted through Kane Chattey but their nine game unbeaten run in the league came to an end when Lower Parkstone CFC surprised them 2-1 thanks to a couple of goals from Karl Littleboy. Electric are now just a point clear at the top from Manor who have two games in hand.

Bournemouth Sports also lost ground when Parley Sports upended them 2-0 with goals from Gary Earl, Trevor Griffin, and Ben Mowlam but third placed Westover Bournemouth remain in contention after Ian Male, Dan Molyneaux, and a Wayne Nagy penalty accounted for Merley Cobham Sports 3-0.

Joe Adams and Luke Lewis netted for Sway but Boldre Royals forced a 2-2 draw through Harry Yates and Ross Hanlon.
