Lewis Mills was the four goal star when Merley Cobham Sports enjoyed their best result of the season so far in the **HAYWARD SATURDAY PREMIER DIVISION**. Alan Marsh, Luke Whittaker, and Scott Nicholson were also on target for Merley in their resounding 7-1 triumph over Redlynch & Woodfalls United whose consolation goal came via James Dorrington.

Reigning champions are a point behind Bournemouth Sports at the summit after Terry Foote, Dave Saunders, Ryan Shaylor, Mickey Finch, and Luke Scrimshaw ensured a 5-2 success against Hamworthy Recreation who replied through Ed Ewens and Anthony Bolton.
