

BHFL SATURDAY ROUND UP - SATURDAY 14th OCTOBER 2017

Bournemouth Electric shocked Bournemouth Manor by opening the scoring after just 15 seconds, sparking a feast of goals with reigning **HAYWARD SATURDAY PREMIER DIVISION** champions Manor eventually emerging 7-5 winners. Former Electric men Danny Taylor and Luke McCoy scored for Manor along with Terry Foote (2), Luke Pidgley, Ed Ewens, and Darren Spiers. Lucas Gelsleichter bagged a brace for the Sparkies with the other goals coming via Kieron Mulvey, Jordan Basing, and an own goal.

Bournemouth Sports lead the table on goal difference from Manor though after Ian Musselwhite hit struggling Boldre Royals for six in a 13-0 romp with Ollie Bolton (2), Nathan Edwards (2), Phil Nicolaou (2), and Scott Rogers also on target.

Former pacesetters Lower Parkstone CFC netted through Jerry Harrison but they had to settle for a point when Joe Bond earned Westover Bournemouth a 1-1 draw.

Mark Wheeler struck for Parley Sports but it was not quite enough to save them from a 2-1 defeat against Alderholt whose goals came from Tom Barrett and Mark Desborough.

Levi Ridealgh bagged a brace for AFC Burton but Merley Cobham Sports opened their points account by winning 5-2 courtesy of Danny Edwards (2), Matt Davis, James Soulsby, and an own goal.

DIVISION ONE pacesetters Bournemouth Manor Reserves netted through Sam Goodwin but Portcastrian came back with second half goals from Jimmy Carter and Ben Shephard to topple them 2-1.

Bournemouth University take over on top after Ashley Coleman, Adam Dawes, and Tom Symons ensured a 3-0 victory over Bournemouth University.

Mudford Mens Club go third on goal difference after Jamie Fields scored both goals in their 2-1 win over Bournemouth Electric Reserves and AFC Pennington were also 2-1 winners when Danny Veal and Ryan Lakey put paid to Bransgore United.
