

HAYWARD SATURDAY LEAGUE ROUND UP

Hundred per cent Bournemouth Manor need just four points from their four remaining league games to become champions of the **HAYWARD SATURDAY PREMIER DIVISION** after Terry Foote struck twice to subdue Allendale 4-1. Adam Janes and Shane Barney were the other Manor marksmen with Billy McCormick replying for 'Dale.

Manor had taken over on top of the table with a 5-1 midweek triumph over Ferndown Sports thanks to goals from Terry Foote, Lee Clarke, Sam Goodwin, Martin Sault, and Mark Reilly.

The league leaders are in cup action tonight (Tuesday) when they meet Westover Bournemouth at Hurn Bridge in the **M.A. Hart Poole Bay Challenge Cup Final**.

Westover Bournemouth, meanwhile, had Sam Rae and Rafael Santos on target in a 2-2 draw with Parley Sports who replied through Darren Orchard and Ben Mowlam.

Reigning champions Bournemouth Electric had to play 70 minutes with ten men after Joe Kittle saw red but they managed to get the better of second placed Bournemouth Sports 1-0 courtesy of a William Rocas strike.

Joe Baldwin netted for Ferndown Sports but they had to settle for a point when Mohamed Kennou earned Alderholt a 1-1 draw. Alderholt were on the trophy trail during the week when they won Wiltshire's **Lord Bledisloe Cup Final** 2-0 against DI United with goals from Tom Barrett and substitute Luke Homer.

Adam Locke and Joe Bond bagged two each when Gotham moved off the bottom of the table with a resounding 6-0 triumph over Hamworthy Recreation with Lyam Telxceira and Scott Hancox adding one apiece.

Chris Jackson struck twice with Mike Joy and Harry Rogers adding one each when Redlynch & Woodfalls United opened Bisterne United 4-0 to move up to third place in **DIVISION ONE**.
