Meanwhile, championship rivals Portcastrian were 3-1 winners against West Howe with goals from Stevie Rattue, Tommy Davies, and Steve Crawford with their host's consolation goal coming via Jamie Tuvey.

Throop United clinched the **DIVISION THREE** title with three games still to play when they brushed third placed Fordingbridge Turks aside 2-0. Mark Jimmy opened the scoring from the edge of the area and John Bailey added the second goal in the closing stages.
