Although approximately half the Hayward Sunday League fixtures had to be postponed due to rainfall, the playing surface at Merley was perfect for Abbey who produced a polished performance to subdue Brit Sports 7-0 in **DIVISION ONE**. Sam Lanahan led the way with a hat-trick while Richie Sands, Jack Holland, Dan Manuel, and former Sports front man Simon Bereznicki added one each for third placed Abbey.
