BHFL HAYWARD SATURDAY LEAGUE ROUND UP

Jolyan May struck for Westover Bournemouth but their excellent start to the season came to an abrupt end when Bournemouth Manor gave them a 5-1 drubbing through Adam Janes, Brad Aspin and a Terry Foote hat-trick to open up a five point lead at the top of the **HAYWARD SATURDAY PREMIER DIVISION**.

Nick Park, Luke Blissett, and Matt Riggs netted for nearest rivals Allendale but they had to settle for a point when a couple of own goals and a Luke Dart strike enabled Merley Cobham Sports to hold them to a 3-3 draw.
