



Verwood Town v Sway

Bournemouth Senior Cup Quarter Final



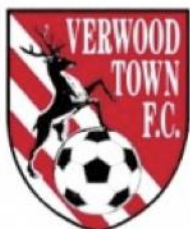
Sway took a commanding early lead in this game against the struggling Wessex Side with two goals in the first 12 minutes. The first was a keeper error when a half-hearted shot from Mark Brading ran through the fingers of Verwood's netminder Ben Daniels on 6 minutes and the second from a blistering shot from Tom Munday on 12 minutes, the deficit unnerved the hosts and it looked for a while that the game was done as a contest. When Sway made it 3-0 on 37 minutes with Ryan Brading lobbing the Home keeper, that feeling was all but confirmed. But Verwood struck back in the 44th minute as the half drew to a close with Joe Kimber breaking through the Sway back line to get one back for the home side. And give them hope. Half Time 1-3

Verwood started the second half as a team on a mission, the half time dressing room dress down that had obviously been handed out, had the desired effect and Sway no longer commanded the game. Verwood's reward was a scrabbled second goal on 49 minutes and now it was really game on. Some devilish tackling that had been evident from the outset now was the norm and referee Mark Bradley had his hands full to contain it as the visitors began to struggle to stay in the game. Had Verwood's passing been of a higher standard they would have romped away with the match. As it was substitutes and cautions was the name of the remainder of the second half with a few chances mostly at the visitors goal being created without effect. Almost with the last gasp of the time added on Verwood found the all important equalizer through Callum O'Hare's shot from 10 yards and sent the game into extra time. Full Time 3-3

No further goals resulted from the additional period only a second yellow for dissent reduced Sway to 10 men as substitute Spencer Churchill was sent from the field just before the mid point but the tired legs of the Home side could not make use of the

advantage

The outcome would ultimately decided with sways last strike of the ball Their last of the five statutory penalties was sent high and wide left of the goal by Mark Brading (*Pic Top Right*) leaving Joe Kimber to slot home Verwood's reply (*Pic Bottom Right*) and seal the 5-4 win in the shootout.
