Westover Bournemouth returned to winning ways in the **HAYWARD SATURDAY PREMIER DIVISION** with a 3-0 victory over Bransgore United thanks to Lee Milton and couple of goals from leading marksman Rory Ward.

Bisterne were quickly on terms through Ash Jones and they clinched all three points when Jamie Barrett slotted home the winner at the far post.
