Bournemouth Electric Reserves take over on top of **DIVISION ONE** after John Taylor, Abraham Adesoji, and Lucas Gelsleichter clinched a 3-1 success against Bournemouth Manor Reserves who replied through Liam Carpenter. Leon Jarrett was the four goal star when Milford hammered Bournemouth Sports 7-0 to go second in the table with the other goals coming via Matt Vining (2) and Ryan Vaughan. Lee Pearson struck twice in Gotham's 3-0 victory over Mudeford Mens Club with Stuart Marshall also on target while Ryan Hamm scored all three goals when Bransgore United shaded it 3-2 against AFC Burton Reserves. Scott Jennings and Sam Young were the Burton scorers.
