RUSHMERE'S KIRSTY BAGS LATE EQUALISER

For the second time in three weeks *Rushmere* salvaged a 2-2 draw against unbeaten DIVISION ONE leaders *FC Hajduk* with a second half equaliser. On this occasion it was a dramatic overhead kick from a corner by Kirsty Emishili in the dying seconds of stoppage time that frustrated the reigning champions. Jon Watt had opened the scoring for *Rushmere* in the 14th minute with *Hajduk* replying midway through the second half with goals from substitute Will Hodge and Sami Makhloufi.
